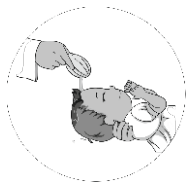

So much blood was flowing, so that the altar cloth was fully soaked. As he was looking the priest disappeared and instead there stood a man disfigured, wounded from head to foot. Jayakumar felt that the wounded person was looking at him only. Love and compassion radiated from his eyes. Then that person spoke to Jayakumar "you are precious and are my beloved". When he recovered from the shock of this vision, in the words of St. Paul "when you are in Christ the old has gone and new has come". In his mouth was only the name of Jesus, in his ears the words of Jesus and his heart was overflowing with divine love. In course of time Jayakumar became Immanuel and his entire family accepted Christianity. When He descended on Mount Sinai in smoke and cloud, He had instructed Moses that people should be kept outside the demarcation and no one should cross it or touch the mount. Because Jesus appears in such a simple way, we approach Him in a very casual way, either due to our lack of understanding or due to negligence. St. P Paul warns us very strongly. (3) Become a bread and break yourself for others. When some one asked St. Mother Theresa, how was she managing to do so much of menial job, her answer was that "My best nourishment is the Body and Blood of Jesus which I receive everyday without fail". For every saints upheld by Catholic Church the BLESSED SACRAMENT WAS THEIR inspiration and strength.

Permit me to share little bit of my personal feelings. I am always in groans and mourns whenever I stand before the alter where the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus my Saviour and Lord is repeated in the memory of Jesus at the hands of the Celebrant. Being the first woman of Indian origin to be canonized as a saint and having faced so many difficulties growing up but yet being a powerful figure and not once losing hope. She never failed to inspire hundreds of young girls and I can proudly say I am one of them.

In 2019 for a short film I was assigned the role of Saint Alphonsa, my knowledge about her story was very little to nothing but the role opened a window for me. I wasn't just well informed about St. Alphonsa but she strongly influenced me. Today I feel immensely blessed for getting the role of St. Alphonsa which let me get close and know her beautiful soul. The intensity of difficulties she faced as a young girl such as the loss of her mother at a very young age and constant bullying by school mates had no power to stop her. She continued being a strong person and dedicated her life to Jesus Christ. St. Alphonsa has given me a spark that shines everytime I face an obstacle which encourages me, and has made Jesus the reason my spark shines even brighter by making him the center of my life.

Her story emphasizes how no obstacle is bigger or stronger than the love of God. It has and will always be God's mighty plan and we need to trust in it, just like St. Alphonsa always said and quoted, "Lord, do with me as if I am your own."

The new academic year 2023-2024 begins:

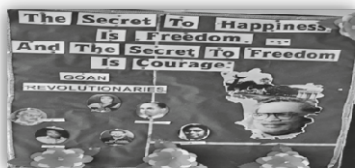
