Bap, Put ani Povitr Atmo, teg zonn punn ek Dev. Hem amchea bhavartachem poilem ani mukhel sot. To ek ghutt zo amchea monis soimban vo gineanan attapunk zaina. Hem sot amkam kheritponnim Jezun ugttem kelam Tachea Povitr Snana disa jedna Bapan Taka Aplo chodd mogacho Put mhunn dakhoun dilo ani Povitr Atmo ek parveachea rupan Tacher yeun boslo. Juanvachea Xubvortomantant Jezu mhonnnta, *“Ani Hanv Bapa kodde magtolom ani To tumkam ek Xaroti ditolo, ani Ho tumche sovem sodankal astolo”* (Ju 14, 16). CORPUS CHRISTI

The feast of the Corpus Christi is Latin for the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, we give special honour to Jesus, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament of the altar.

Jesus said: With all earnestness I possess I tell you this: Unless you eat the flesh of the Messiah and drink His blood, you cannot have eternal life within you. But anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life within you. But anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him at the Last Day. For my flesh is the true food, and my blood is the true drink. Everyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood is in me and I in him. I am the true Bread from heaven; and anyone who eats this Bread shall live forever (John 6:53-56, 58).

St. Ignatius of Antioch in his letter to the Ephesians written before 110AD refers to the Eucharist as the medicine of immortality and the antidote against death, enabling us to live forever in Jesus Christ.

The emphasis of this feast is unity. When we share a meal together it breaks down walls and moves us close to unity. Jesus knew what he was doing when he chose this Eucharistic meal as a means of continuing to be with us bodily. He knew it would be the best way to keep us united to Him and one another.

Let us pray for those who do not believe in the transubstantiation (the conversion of the substance of the Eucharistic elements into the body and blood of Christ at consecration) and mislead us saying it is a lie being told and there is no need to go Church. This was told to me last week by a person of the neighbouring village living in Canberra, Australia for the last 34 years.

Let us ponder on the words of our Saint Padre Pio, "If people knew the value of the Mass, there would be policemen at the door to regulate access to the Church, every time that Mass is celebrated!"

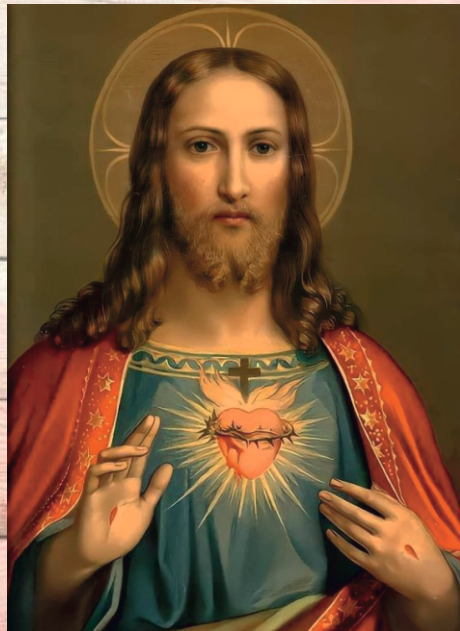

THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

One of the most popular Marian devotions in the Catholic Church is that of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The Immaculate Heart of Mary signifies great purity and the burning love of the heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary for God the Father, her son Jesus Christ and all mankind.

The word 'Immaculate' is derived from a Latin word 'Immaculatus' which means free from moral stain. Mary was conceived without the original sin and was preserved from committing any actual sins throughout the course of her life. Her soul was adorned with all of the virtues as well as the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit at the moment of her conception. At the Annunciation, the Archangel Gabriel declared Mary as "Full of Grace" and this fullness of grace emanates from the center of her being – her Heart. Mary's heart is the source and wellspring of her purity and is thus called Immaculate.

Mary's heart being Immaculate, she was able to love God in a way He should be loved. She bestowed her immense motherly love on Jesus and was called to share in and co-operate in His redemptive sufferings. She outpours her compassionate love on us, at every moment and has a great desire to bring all souls to her son Jesus.

Devotion to Mary's heart existed among Theologians and Saints for many ages, but it was the French priest, St. John Eudes, who actively promoted this devotion into liturgical practice that we observe today. In 1805, Pope Pius VII allowed a feast to honour the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

On 13th July 1917, our Blessed Mother Mary appeared to three children - Jacinta and Francisco Marto and their cousin Lucia dos Santos in Fatima, Portugal and said "To save poor sinners, God wishes to establish in the world, devotion to my Immaculate Heart". Later in

1942, at the 25th Anniversary of the last apparition of Our Lady of Fatima, Pope Pius XII consecrated the world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The same year, he assigned the Feast day to August 22, the octave of the Solemnity of the Assumption. On 4th May, 1944, he extended the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary to the Universal Church.

With the liturgical reforms of the Second Vatican Council in 1969, Pope Paul VI moved the celebration of the Immaculate Heart of Mary to the Saturday, immediately after the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Thus in practice, it is now held on the third Saturday after Pentecost.

Mary's Immaculate Heart consists of her contemplative, maternal heart, wreathed by a crown of roses, pierced with a sword and alight with fire.

Mary's heart which is visible outside of her body, points to her undying love for all people which she cannot contain within. Her heart which is typically on fire, emphasizes the intensity of her love for God and for humanity.

The white roses that encircle her heart symbolize her purity, brought about by her Immaculate Conception, creating within her a most pure heart.

A single sword going through her heart, reminds us of the prophecy of Simeon in the Gospel of Luke 2:35 (“a sword will pierce through your own soul”) and indicates the sorrows she endured during her lifetime, particularly during the crucifixion.

The heart typically surrounded by rays of light brings to our mind the sacred scriptures from the Book of Revelation 12:1, where the Blessed Virgin Mary is described as “a woman clothed with the sun.”

Mary's pondering heart was crushed at the foot of the cross and was vivified by the Christ's resurrection. She experienced both joys and sorrows and yet remained faithful to God. The Immaculate Heart of Mary is a perfect model for all of us to imitate and thus grow more deeply in the mystery of God's love. As we celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on June 17, let us make our hearts a fitting home for the Holy Spirit and infuse them with love like Mary.

We need a rallying cry which impels decisive action whenever we feel low, right? A positive affirmation with the resonance and emotive charge of, for instance, *Give me liberty, or give me death!* Or, how about *Be reasonable, demand the impossible!?*

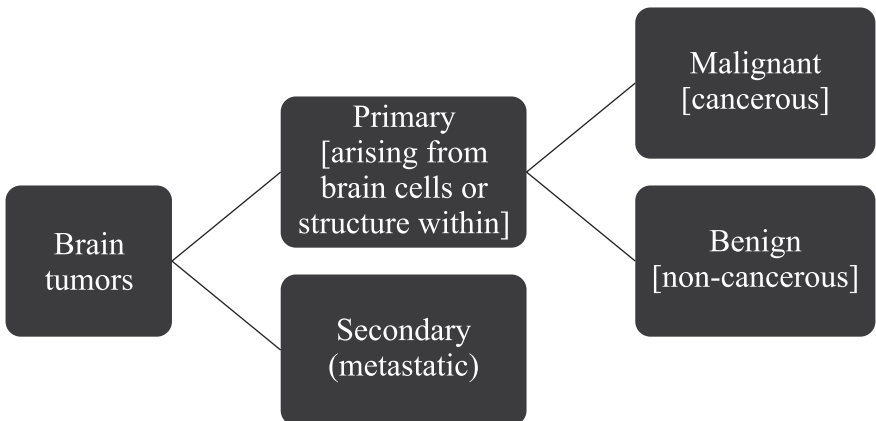
WORLD BRAIN TUMOR DAY

Since we are celebrating 8th June as World Brain Tumor Day, I would like to share my knowledge and experiences. For last 10 years I have been working as Assistant Lecturer in department of Neurology in Goa Medical College.

During my usual OPD days once a *woman in her fifties* came to me saying **“Dotor mhoji tokli samki dukta, 2-3 vorsa zali, maka bhoi podla tumor bi zaum na ni maka”**. After taking her detailed history and examination, it looked like migraine/ T.T.H. I got her screened with blood tests and CT Brain which was normal. Another *young male* in his early thirties came to me complaining of episode of seizure and dull headache, though patient was relaxed and calm. i.v.o seizure and since on examination got subtle weakness on one side. Doing CT Brain, found to have large frontal meningioma.

TYPES OF BRAIN TUMORS



Who Do Brain Tumors Affect

Brain tumor can affect children, adults and can develop at any age. Some has a genetic cause but in most cases exact cause is not known.

How Serious Are the Brain Tumors

Brain tumors whether cancerous or not, can cause serious problem as skull is rigid and does not provide room for tumor to expand.

Signs And Symptoms of Brain Tumor

Signs and symptoms depend on tumor location, size and type. They can include

- *Headache* that may be more severe in the morning or wake you up at night
- Seizures
- Weakness in one part or one side of body (paralysis)
- Balance problem (unsteadiness)
- Vision issues
- Hearing issues
- Facial numbness/tingling
- Vomiting
- Behavioral changes like confusion, disorientation (memory issues)

Some people who have brain tumor experience no symptoms especially when it is too small.

Tests to be done to diagnose

- CT Brain
- MRI Brain
- Other specific tests like tumor marker tests, lumbar puncture can be required in certain case

Treatment

- Brain tumor treatment depends on several factors including the tumor location, size, type, number of tumors, age of patient, general condition.
- Benign tumors can be removed with surgery, don't usually grow back
- In case of malignant tumors, brain surgery, radiation therapy, brachytherapy, chemotherapy which is decided by neurosurgeon and oncologists.

To sum up, if you experience any of the above mentioned symptoms, kindly visit a doctor and get yourself checked, it may not be a tumor but may be some other disease. **Early detection, better the prognosis.**
