

The S.S.C Batch of 2023-2024 were given their farewell on 5th



BALANCED DIET

Reggie Mouse had a singular diet consisting only of cheese, much to the concern of his mother, Rita Mouse. She persistently encouraged Reggie to diversify his diet with healthy options such as fruits, vegetables, cereals, breads, chicken, and fish. Despite his initial resistance, Reggie's realization came when he noticed his clothes seemingly shrinking, prompting him to finally heed his mother's advice. Incorporating a variety of healthy foods into his diet, Reggie quickly noticed positive changes, humorously reflected in his clothes 'unshrinking'.

This tale underscores the importance of a **balanced diet**, essential for providing the necessary nutrition and energy to support the body's cells, tissues, organs, and overall growth and development. An imbalanced diet can lead to numerous health issues, including poor growth, mental health problems, infectious diseases, and diet-related conditions like obesity and heart disease. A healthy diet should include a mix of carbohydrates, proteins, fats, and micronutrients such as vitamins and minerals.

Carbohydrates, vital for the brain, heart, and nervous tissues, should be consumed in forms that offer vitamins, minerals, and fiber, aiding in weight management and digestive health. **Proteins** are crucial for tissue repair, immune function, and maintaining fluid balance, with sources including dairy, soybeans, and various meats. **Fats**,

necessary for energy and vitamin transport, should be balanced between saturated and unsaturated types, with a focus on healthier options like olive oil and omega-3 rich foods.

The recommended dietary allowances (**RDA**) suggest a diet composed mainly of carbohydrates (65%), with adequate protein (1g/kg of body weight) and limited fats (3-4 tsp of oil plus 1 tsp of ghee daily). Incorporating a variety of fruits, vegetables, grains, and dairy ensures a well-rounded diet. Vegetables and pulses contribute essential vitamins and minerals, while fruits offer a natural source of carbohydrates and fiber. **Nuts and seeds** are excellent for their mineral content and vitamins, and grains provide additional vitamins and minerals. Dairy products, especially low-fat options, are important for protein and healthy fats.

Addressing **vitamin and mineral deficiencies** is crucial for preventing conditions like bone disorders, scurvy, night blindness, skin diseases, and poor blood clotting. Smart eating habits also involve mindful eating practices, such as taking time to chew food, avoiding distractions during meals, and listening to the body's hunger cues. Hydration plays a vital role in overall health, with recommendations to drink ample water and limit intake of sodium, caffeine, and alcohol. Preparing and consuming healthful foods like vegetable-rich soups can further enhance well-being.

WORLD HERITAGE DAY.

(Focus on Chandor Heritage Village)

World heritage day, held annually on 18 th April is about increasing the awareness of the importance of cultural heritage and preserving for generations in the future.

Chandor- A heritage village: The 1st capital of Goa, Chandra Aura (Bhoj Dynasty) , Chandrapura(Kadamba Dynasty) is presently known as Chandor .

Elements of Chandor as heritage village:

Tangible,Intangible culture and Natural heritage of Chandor.

Tangible culture:

Setting up a Museum in Chandor:

- 1 Collecting , Preserving and displaying of artefacts, ,potteries, tanks etc of the excavation site at Mahadev(Shiva) Temple and Nandi bull, Devllantholoi(Temple tank)Digital Archiving,3D scanning of heritage elements, Virtual museum for education.
2. Fortification walls of Chandor Khott should be conserved wherever possible and the main gate St Tiago Chapel restored.
- 3 Davarne (Load rests) erected at many places along the road should be reconstructed with some murals.
- 4 Conserve the sites at Mamlatemer , Devlla Balm at Bindimol,Bansor and other Kovddi sites.
5. Preserve the Chandor Monuments and Ancestral houses of.Bragancas, Fernandes etc. and other Portuguese houses by providing maintenance fund. Also, the front facade of the dilapidated houses in Kotta be restored .

Intangible culture.

- 1. The Mussoll Khel-** folk dance is the most significant symbol of historical and cultural folklore ,and Kunbi Tribal dance and festival of tribes.
- 2. Kott- Hapshi:** ghost of forebear. In Cotta village and Queen's curse (folk stories).
- 3. Nossa Sra De Belem Church:** “Three Kings Feast” Santos Passos, Good Friday , processions are held, where the villagers assemble on the Mount ,Chapel of Our Lady Piety,,..a great spiritual tradition .

Natural heritage:

- 1. Our unique canal irrigation system and our water catchment areas,Bandh etc.**
- 2. Restoration of Lake Oilem Tollem, and Old laterite Bridges at Cotta and Cavorim, Underground Springs at Xitem, Moddlem, Colosso, Igorjebhat etc.desilting of Matoli water body.**

3. Murals/Stone art/Wooden carving. etc

At the entry of 6 arterial roads to our CGC village , the photos of our great personalities, viz Freedom fighters,18 th century Doctors on horseback (Goddeam Voiz),other great personalities etc & following heritage objects can be displayed:

Other heritage objects:Carreira(old bus),Bullock cart, Machila (Pallequins),Chandor Bull(Redde),Paddy farm to food and Coconut based products,(traditional methods). Mandris (traditional mats) woven from wild grass (lavo).

Structural mini models of old Chandor Rly station,Old Tinto,Temple and traditional Hindu House, Escola Primaria.

PANDEMIC MEMORIES

Is it too soon to talk about the pandemic as though it was something we experienced a long, long time ago? We do still receive Whatsapp forwards, don't we, telling us to watch out every time a newer variant of the virus emerges? (Remember omicron, anyone?). This has been going on for over a year now and, rather like in the story of the boy who cried wolf, we seem to have had enough of these panicky alarms. Have you seen anyone wearing a mask lately?

Fortunately, the situation in Goa wasn't as bad as elsewhere in India, as in UP for instance, where people were actually disposing bodies off in the Ganges. Nor was it as bad as during the pandemic a century ago, when villagers in Raia even put up a cross after, with a plaque, to mark the event. What I was struck by, though, was how casually people were taking covid-related deaths – no condolence visits, no attending funerals, nothing. Some people went off into the sunset without anyone even knowing till we heard of their passing much, much later. One did get a start, of course, but we were not shocked. It became easier to get used to the idea of not being around anymore and people quickly forgetting that we had even existed!

For me, the starker recollection is a few of us meeting at the church patio around twilight time and shooting the breeze. All of us wore masks and all, except for one hold-out, had taken the vaccine and the boosters. He held out because some close relatives had caught the virus despite having been vaccinated twice. We discussed the latest deaths, and death itself, quite matter-of-factly. In fact, so nonchalantly that whenever we were dispersing to go home, it became a routine to say, laughing, "See you tomorrow, if we are still around!"

As we say in English, *c'est la vie!*

In His revelations to St. Faustina, our Lord asked for this special prayer and meditation on His Passion each afternoon at three o'clock, the hour that recalls His death on the cross.

When St. Pope John Paul II canonised St. Faustina he established the Divine Mercy Sunday as a feast day for the entire Church. The feast day falls on the Second Sunday of the Easter season.
