After the session we had a small activity wherein we were asked to make a friendship web with Jesus in the center and we had to connect ourselves to it signifying that we all are connected through Christ.

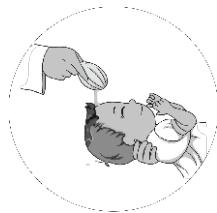
The program ended by cutting of a cake and a small vote of thanks making this celebration a memorable one.

THE ARCHANGELS

Archangel are angels considered to be in the highest rank of angels, who are also known as Watchers, as they tend to humanity - they are considered to be very powerful spiritual beings that have captured our attention for centuries, The prefix 'arch' means ruling or chief, in Greek language.

Although tradition says there are seven archangels, the Catholic Church invokes only three of them, whose names are found in the Holy Scriptures. They are Archangel Michael, Archangel Gabriel and Archangel Raphael, whose feast is celebrated on the 29th of September.

St. Michael: His name means 'Who is like God?' which is in reference to the battle between the fallen angels and the archangels. Lucifer (satan) wanted to be like God; St. Michael was his antithesis. In the Bible, Michael is the angel general and the advocate for the people of Israel, he appeared in Daniel's visions while in the lions den and leads God's armies with a mighty sword against satan as revealed in the Book of Revelation. He is said to be the patron saint of the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist.

St. Gabriel: His name translated variously as 'the strength of God', 'hero of God' or 'God has shown Himself mightily'. He is the holy messenger who appeared to the priest Zacharias to tell him that his wife Elizabeth would bear a son whom he will name him as John. He also appeared to Mary to tell her that she would be giving birth to Jesus, the Son of the Most High. He is the patron of the Sacrament of Baptism.

St Raphael: Whose name means, 'God heals' or God's Healer'. He healed Tobit, father of Tobias. Patron of the sacrament of Reconciliation.

The Archangels have the task of contemplating God, day and night, glorifying Him incessantly. They protect the whole mankind. They come to us with much love, acceptance and deep compassion. They also act as a bridge to help us to receive wisdom and divine inspiration.

ST. PADRE PIO

St. Padre Pio was born Francesco Forgione on May 25th, 1887 in Pietrelcina, Italy. He was very religious and by the age of five he made the decision to dedicate his life to God. His family attended daily Mass and Francesco served as an altar boy at his local parish. From a tender age, he had a peculiar ability. He could see guardian



angels, spoke with Jesus and Mother Mary. At the age of 15 he entered the novitiate of the Capuchin Friars and took the name 'Pio' in honour of Pope Pius I, whose relic he often saw at his local Santa Anna Chapel in Pietrelcina.

On one occasion during Prayer, a fellow monk astonishingly reported he saw Pio levitate during an episode of ecstasy. He became a Priest in 1910. On September 20, 1918, Padre Pio was in Prayer when he had the vision of crucified Christ who invited him to let his pains enter into him and meditate on them and at the same time to concern himself with the salvation of others. When he came back to himself he

noticed the Stigmata, the wounds of Christ appearing on his hands and feet and side. Bleeding occurred. The wounds smelled of roses and never became infected. Besides that he was the recipient of other spiritual gifts like bilocation, healing, prophecy and the ability to read souls. He performed many miracles during his life time and he was often known to say “My real mission will begin after my death”

In 1947, Fr. Karol Wojtyla visited Padre Pio who prophetically told him he would rise to the highest post in the Church. Fr. Karol Wojtyla became Pope John Paul II in 1978. Padre Pio died on September 23, 1968 and Pope John Paul II recognized Padre Pio a Saint on June 16, 2002.

Saint Padre Pio is the patron of Civil defense volunteers, adolescents and village of Pietrelcina. His five rules for Spiritual growth are weekly confession, daily communion, spiritual reading, meditation and examination of conscience .His famous words are “Pray, hope and don't worry. Worry is useless. God is merciful and will hear your prayer.”

Let us pray to this great Saint to intercede to God on our behalf and who had a great devotion to Mother Mary, particularly through the Holy Rosary. “Love the Madonna and pray the Rosary, for her Rosary is the weapon against all evils of the world today. All graces given by God pass through the Blessed Mother.” When asked if the Blessed Virgin is present during the Holy Mass Saint Padre Pio replied, “Yes, she places herself at a side, but I can see her, what a joy. She is always present. How can it be that the Mother of Jesus, present in the Calvary at the foot of the Cross, who offered her Son as a victim for the salvation of our souls, not be present in the mystical Calvary of the altar?”

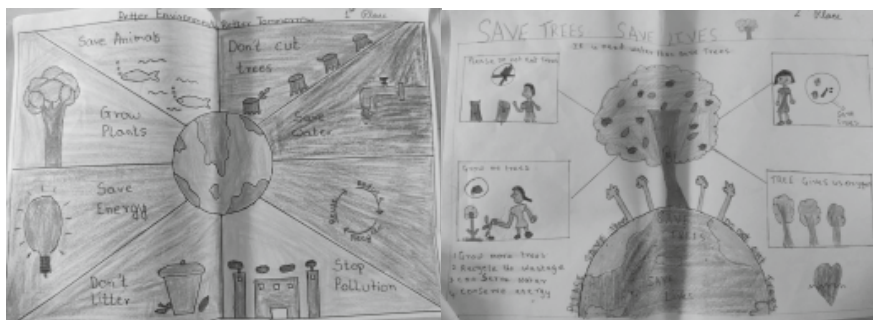

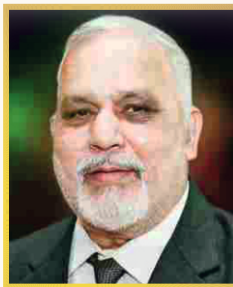
